



- Overall subscriptions (mailing lists, media list and specialised lists): 7009.




Significant surge in user engagement

ACB's website and social media platforms saw a significant surge in engagement during the reporting period.

- The number of active users on the website grew by 75% year-on-year, while engaged users increased by 54%.
- On Facebook, our reach expanded by over 200%, accompanied by a 55% rise in content interactions.
- Instagram content interactions also doubled, reflecting a 100% year-on-year increase.


